SAFETY HARBOR, Fla. – The Safety Harbor Art and Music Center (SHAMc), announced Monday, a lineup of nationally acclaimed musical acts, scheduled to perform at the sixth annual Safety Harbor Song Fest on Apr. 5-7. What's different this year is the event is being held in three indoor venues instead of the waterfront park as in years past.

The festival's confirmed lineup includes national recording artists, Randall Bramblett, Shawn Mullins, Ross Newell, The Currys, Seth Walker, Sugarcane Jane, Jocelyn & Chris Arndt, Reverend Sekou, Delta Rae, Eliot Bronson, Hannah Harber, and multiple Grammy winner Trae Pierce. This year's artists draw inspiration from a wide range of musical genres, including blues, indie alternative, folk, bluegrass, country, jazz, pop, world beat and more.

This year, the acts will be spread out over three days at the following venues: Friday, Safety Harbor Art & Music Center; Saturday, Margaret Haye Great Room at Ruth Eckerd Hall; and Sunday, Crooked Thumb Brewery.
